

Fundação Estudar boosted more than 450 careers

São Paulo, April 2010 - Along its 19 years of work, Fundação Estudar, a non-profit organization created by entrepreneurs with the objective of forming future leaderships to the country, has already contributed to 453 young people, helping them to achieve high quality education in top universities. Not only through scholarships, but also counseling their professional development and helping to create a prolific and useful network, becoming aware of good career opportunities.

Among the 453 scholars, 56% studied abroad. In 2009, 38 out of 86 scholars studied in universities from other countries. Fundação invests, on average, 1,6 million reais in scholarships a year.

Since 1991, Fundação has already sent students to 87 top universities, in Brazil and abroad. When it comes to the American Ivy League, group of universities in the United States that includes Brown, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Princeton, Harvard, Yale and University of Pennsylvania, we sent 88 scholars.

Every year, 40 new students, on average, are selected. However, there is no limit of scholarships per year. The selection process regards academic excellence, leadership, social compromise, entrepreneurship and ethics.

Currently, nearly 80 scholars work in some of the 37 enterprises that support Fundação Estudar's projects. Within our graduated scholars, 30% work in the service sector, 30% in financial institutions, 22% in the industry, 9% in the trade area, 5% in education, 2% in the government and 2% in non-profit companies. In the same group, 4% are CEOs of big corporations, 13% directors and 11% entrepreneurs of different kinds of businesses.
